

ASA-IM HOLDS SUCCESSFUL FEED SEMINARS IN KAGOSHIMA

ASA-IM Japan successfully held a feed seminar for commercial feed suppliers and swine producers in Kagoshima, which is the largest swine producing Prefecture in Japan. More than 25 major feed manufacturer and livestock producer technical, production and marketing staff participated in a half day ASA-IM Japan Technical Feed Seminar moderated by Japan Country Director Brabant and ASA-IM Japan Animal Nutritionist and Feed Consultant Maekawa who provided a presentation focused on achieving feed efficiencies through the use of feed formulation that include high levels of Soybean Meal in swine production and feeding. Also on hand was R&D Director Ohkuma of Bussan Biotech Japan who presented a session about the role digestive enzymes play in livestock feeding and production. The following day, ASA-IM Japan Consultant Maekawa provided an on-site swine feed workshop for the management and senior staff of The Japan Farm, currently the largest pig farm in Kyushu, with more than 9,000 sows. Kagoshima producers are keen to realize additional feed efficiencies given the current environmental and management challenges which require least cost production.
